

Schnucks eScrip Cards

Here's an easy way to support St. Louis Genealogical Society. It's *free* if you shop at Schnucks grocery stores. You can turn your grocery bills into contributions to the St. Louis Genealogical Society by using a Schnucks eScrip Community Card. These cards are now available at our office or at any Schnucks store.

Q. What is a Schnucks eScrip Community Card?

A. It looks like a credit card, but it simply identifies the St. Louis Genealogical Society as being the recipient of a cash donation from Schnucks.

Q. What does it cost?

A. Nothing. There is no charge for the card, there are no fees to use the card, and it adds no charges to your grocery bill.

Q. What do I need to do?

A. Simply pick up a free card. To activate the card you must call the toll-free number (1-800-931-6258) and give them the Society's name or ID number (#500017109).

Q. How do I use the card?

A. When you check out, give the card to the cashier *before* you complete your check-out.

Q. How much money will Schnucks donate to the Society?

A. Depending on your monthly grocery spending, Schnucks will donate a dollar amount to the Society between 1% and 3% of your total spending.

Q. I already have a Schnucks card that is contributing money to another organization. Can I still have it contribute to the Society?

A. Yes. Simply call the toll-free number (1-800-931-6258) and ask them to add the Society's name or ID number (#500017109) to your current card. The funds will then be shared between both organizations.
